

FM 36 Construction Work and Construction of SH 66 Right-Turn Lane at FM 36

PARIS – The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) officials have announced the upcoming work for two projects in Hunt County.

Work will start on FM 36 to perform an overlay for the final surface on the delayed segment. This was due to a change in plans needed to provide a smoother ride. This work will begin on Monday, Feb. 23, and continue through Saturday, Mar. 7. Flagging operations will be utilized, and the contractor will be considerate of Peak Hour traffic while directing traffic. Traffic que times will be shortened for school traffic in the AM and PM.

The work will take place from US 380 to Caddo Mills City Limits.

After the completion of paving on FM 36, TxDOT's contractor will be adding a Right-Turn Lane on SH 66 at FM 36. This work is expected to start on Monday, Mar. 9 and will be completed by Thursday, Mar. 12. This work is needed to address the request by City of Caddo Mills, to improve congestion at the intersection of SH 66 and FM 36.

Message boards will be posted and traffic control devices will be in place.

During this period, TxDOT urges drivers to exercise caution. Motorists who travel frequently in this area are asked to pay special attention to all barricades, traffic controls, and signs, and to reduce their speed as they approach and travel through work zones. They should also avoid distractions such as cell phones, eating, drinking, or car audio or navigation systems. TxDOT also asks drivers to remain alert to road crews while navigating through the construction zone.
